<i>Pale yellow in colour. Aromas of ripe apricot &amp; melon with notes of almond and acacia.</i>	
<b>Sancerre, Aurore Dezat, Loire Valley 2018</b>	£34.00
<i>Dry white classic with mineral character and greater ripeness than most. Elegant Sauvignon Blanc. Hints of grapefruit &amp; lemon, beautiful freshness on the palate.</i>	
<b>Chablis 2015 Simonnet Febvre, Burgundy 2017</b>	£40.00
<i>Floral nose and citrus fruits notes. This wine offers lemon and fresh almond aromas with a lively finish.</i>
